



INSTRUCTIONS FOR ATTENDING THE KASDG CONCEALED CARRY TRAINING CLASS

1. Please plan to arrive 15 to 20 minutes prior to the start of class. Full attendance is necessary to meet the state requirements for completing this class. Please do not be late! If you miss the required material, we cannot certify your training.
2. We will break one hour for lunch at approx. noon; lunch will be provided. Classes resume promptly at 1pm!
3. Bring pen and paper.
4. Bring one handgun of your choice.
5. Bring a minimum of 50 rounds of ammunition for the firearm. Factory ammo only, NO RELOADS. The proficiency test requires 25 rounds. How much practice do you want to do? (Note: Do not bring handguns or ammo into the classroom!)
6. Eye and ear protection are mandatory; you may bring any other shooting gear you would normally take to the range.
7. The enrollment fee covers all expenses for the class (e.g. targets, student manual).
8. Dress appropriately and comfortably for the weather. The class will be held, rain or shine; hot or cold. Severe weather may cause delays, but rarely cancellation.
9. We encourage you to become a member of the NRA. If you would like to join the NRA, you will be able to do so at the class. NRA helped to get the CCH law passed in the State of Kansas and many other states.
